

Taos Milagro Rotary Club to Make Two \$1,000

Community Grants

The Taos Milagro Rotary Club Community Grants Program will make two \$1000 grants on or about April 11, 2018. These grants are responsive to the needs of our local community. We seek to impact Taos County by increasing opportunities for people to overcome economic, educational, and social barriers, and to create stronger pathways for people to access services and participate in their communities.

To submit an application for funding to the Taos Milagro Rotary Community Grants Program organizations should have tax exempt 501(C) (3) status and serve the people of Taos County. The community grant program will consider funding grants to schools if projects fall outside their core responsibilities. For individuals or groups representing programs or projects that do not have a 501(C) (3) status the applicant must have a sponsoring non-profit and include a letter of sponsorship.

Maximum Amount for Funding Request: \$1,000.00. Grant applications must be submitted by March 15, 2018. All grant applications will be reviewed through a formal evaluation process. Funding will be approved by the Taos Milagro Rotary Club Board. All applicant organizations will be notified by email of funding decisions.

Community Grants Program Restrictions and Limitations: The Taos Milagro Grants Program does not award grants for religious or political purposes, to individuals, or to government agencies, other than to schools as above. *If you received a Taos Rotary grant within the previous twenty-four months, you are ineligible to apply for the current grant cycle.*
